



Patient Access Optimization Initiative

The goal of the Patient Access Optimization Initiative is to improve scheduling, financial clearance, and registration processes for ambulatory clinic patients. Begun in January and led by an executive committee of key physician and administrative leaders, and aided by external industry experts, the project is identifying opportunities to optimize our current intake process in order to improve patient experience, while also reducing costs. The project has included workflow observations, technology reviews, and interviews with key stakeholders and focus groups to establish ways to streamline operations and enhance patients' pre-visit experience. Three information sessions were held in March to provide updates to and gather feedback from physicians and staff. The working group of clinic, patient access, and call center staff expects to present its recommendations for an improved operational model in mid-April.
