Clinical Pastoral Education at UI Health

Our training program provides a learning opportunity for ministry professionals, seminary students, and qualified lay persons to develop their theoretical, clinical, theological, professional, and personal competencies in the delivery of pastoral care to patients, their families, staff and students.

We offer an interfaith program developed by the Institute for Clinical Pastoral Training (ICPT) which is dedicated to offering a standardized and evidenced-based Clinical Pastoral Education (CPE) training program to chaplains and spiritual care providers.

What Makes Our CPE Program Unique?

Chaplaincy students involved in a unit of clinical pastoral education receive:

- A minimum of 400 hours of training
- No less than 100 hours of structured group and individual education combined with
- Supervised clinical practice in ministry.



Since UI Health has a Palliative Care Service and a dedicated Palliative Care chaplain, the students will have exposure to palliative care as a part of their training.

ICPT's Hybrid Learning units blend face-to-face classroom instruction, with on-line meetings and training. This allows CPE supervisors to deploy technology with face-to-face teaching to meet the unique needs of our learners.
